



Sunu Euleük, Sunu Ecosystème - Supporting the transition towards agroecological territories (Senegal, Kaolack)

Context

The Sunu Ęulėuk, Sunu Ecosystem project aims to support the transition from rain-fed agriculture to resilient peasant agriculture that strengthens food sovereignty while respecting the balance of ecosystems. The sustainable restoration of productive bases, the control of the water cycle and secured access to land are key drivers of this desired evolution.

Global Objective

Improving community and ecosystem resilience for an agro-ecological transition in the Wack Ngouna district.

Specific Objectives

- SO1: Strengthen initiatives to restore agricultural production through agroecological practices
- SO 2: Strengthen the capacities of local actors in terms of integrated management of natural resources and ecosystems

Outcomes /Outputs

(SO1) Expected result 1: The agricultural and commercial practices of women producers are strengthened and integrate the principles of agroecology, moving the terroir towards productive and sustainable landscapes.

(OS1) Expected result 2: Pilot reforestation and runoff optimisation schemes are operational and their sustainable exploitation is ensured

(SO2) Expected result 4: Local actors are strengthened from a technical and organisational point of view, for the restoration of degraded ecosystems and the management of natural resources

OS2 Expected result 5: A general awareness is ensured on the present and future challenges related to climate change, through a transversal, participative and multi-scale sensitisation

OS2 Expected result 6: Local actors take ownership of present and future climate change issues through participatory territorial diagnosis and planning processes supported by the research community
